Together we'll explore the issues central to our work: ensuring quality delivery of curriculum amidst new formats, ensuring equity so that we leave no learner behind, and building, maintaining and encouraging the relationships that are core to ECFE.

Through virtual learning via video conferencing, small group discussion, collaborative document creation and engagement with a variety of interactive learning tools, educators from across the state will jointly identify pathways for successful teaching. This professional development package occurs in 2 parts:

Part 1: A series of three 1 hour conversations among professionals on the topics of adapting curriculum and instruction, equity and access for all learners, and building and maintaining relationships. **These recorded conversations identified the core issues, challenges and questions that will inform our work together in Part 2.**

Part 2: A day long, highly engaging virtual workshop. We will meet together as a full group, and work in small groups appropriate to our practice. Each group will further explore the key areas of curriculum, equity and relationships. The day involves:

- Instructional activities for highly engaged, collaborative virtual learning demonstrated and shared
- Small group discussion and engagement with membership appropriate to individual practice
- Resources shared, along with an online space for collaboration beyond the workshop
- Sufficient stretch, email and food breaks throughout the day to avoid Zoom-fatigue
- Technology use "how to" hints and support for use of all platforms during the day, and beyond
- All sessions will be recorded and available for later viewing in a selected YouTube playlist
- Laughter, camaraderie, and optimism
