

ECFE Parent Educator (part-time)- Watertown-Mayer

Responsible to plan, manage, and implement developmentally appropriate, research-based curriculum and culturally relevant learning activities that address and assess all early childhood indicators of progress domains in a safe and enriching learning activities. The Parent Educator will work within an Early Learning Team to build parent and student skills in such a way that promotes high level outcomes for all.

The Parent Educator will teach up to five ECFE Classes per week in the morning and may teach up to two evenings per week. In addition the Parent Educator may be asked to support administering promotional materials and welcoming families with young children to the district.

Salary is based on the district's master contract ECFE Teacher Salary Schedule.

- Current Minnesota Teaching License in Parent Education required; Early Childhood preferred in addition
- Minimum of two year experience working with infants, toddlers and/or preschool age children and their parents preferred
- Superb written, oral and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work collaboratively and maintain positive relationships with students, parents, district staff.
- Exceptional organizational skills and attention to detail
- Knowledge of the 2017 Minnesota Early Childhood Indicators of Progress and Parent Education Core Curriculum Framework
